

DECIDING ON AN INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

What to expect:

Traditional Instruction (Brick and Mortar)

- ◆ Students will physically come to their school for their learning.
- ◆ Students will physically see and interact with their teachers and other students.
- ◆ Classroom spaces will be arranged to maximize social distancing.

E-learning (through Armwood)

- ◆ Students will maintain their enrollment at Armwood.
- ◆ They will attend school online during regular school hours and follow a standard school schedule.
- ◆ Teachers will teach “live” each day

Hillsborough Virtual (HVK12)

- ◆ Students will not be enrolled at Armwood.
- ◆ They will need to enroll for HVK12 on www.flvs.net.
- ◆ Students are expected to complete the work at their own pace.
- ◆ Students will access their curriculum and assignments via Canvas Learning Management System.

**** All decisions made will be in effect for 18 weeks****

Options:

1. Traditional Instruction (Brick and Mortar)

Traditional, in-person, face-to-face for grades PK-12 learning following the regular student calendar (180 days of instruction) and bell times.

2. E-learning

Students will attend school online during regular school hours and follow a standard school schedule. Students will remain enrolled at their home school.

3. Hillsborough Virtual (HVK12)

Students will attend school online but will have flexibility when they complete their work and are not tied to a specific bell schedule. Students will be withdrawn from their home school but can re-enroll.
