1. **Field Trip Permission:** Field trips are considered an integral part of a child’s learning experience. It is required that your child have a signed permission slip to participate and go on a field trip. It is very disappointing to a child to forget or lose his/her permission slip. The school is requesting in the interest of all boys and girls, a blanket permission slip allowing your child to go with his/her class on a field trip. It is understood that the school will continue notifying parents of information concerning all field trips.

2. **Photography Permission:** Some phases of our school program, including PTA activities, will be photographed, videotaped and/or filmed. These are used to improve instruction, celebrate student accomplishments, and to create memories for all students. All pictures shall be utilized in accordance with county policies. It will be the school’s understanding that your student will be included in this process unless a written request for exemption is given to the school.

3. **Internet and Computer Permission:** The internet and computers are used daily by students to access curriculum, conduct research, enhance learning, take advantage of purchased online programs, and most importantly develop much needed computer skills for life and career readiness. All internet activity is protected by the Hillsborough County School District to protect against improper use or access using firewalls and will deny any activity that is/or could be considered improper. It will be the school’s understanding that your student will be included in this process unless a written request for exemption is given to the school. Students are expected to utilize the technology appropriately during the school day to support the learning environment. Misuse of the internet or devices, could result in restriction of the utilization of technology.
