

ALTC Firefighter Program – Admissions Checklist

Tampa Fire Rescue (August 24 – November 24, 2020)

All potential students must attend the Orientation session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, July 28. A lottery will be held following the Orientation session to award open seats to our recent EMT graduates. Students who are awarded a seat must set an appointment with our Guidance Counselor and complete the Registration process by August 14. Those awarded a seat will receive an email with a link to set a registration appointment.

The following 12 items must be submitted at Registration. Partial paperwork is not accepted.

1. ____ Residency Form (See page 2 of form and provide 2 proofs documenting 1 year or more residency in FL)
2. ____ Hold Harmless Form - **Notarized** (original)
3. ____ Personal Inquiry Waiver Form - **Notarized** (original)
4. ____ Training Affidavit - **Notarized** (original)
5. ____ Tobacco Affidavit – **Notarized** (original)
6. ____ Copy of Driver’s License or State of Florida Photo ID
7. ____ Florida EMT, Florida Medic, NREMT license, **or** a Diploma/Certificate dated within the last year from an approved EMT program
8. ____ Original High School diploma, original GED, sealed High School transcript, or sealed advanced degree transcript from an approved, accredited US school
9. ____ Medical Examination Form - **Must** be on the form **given at Orientation**
10. ____ Application for FF Certification Exam – **Must** be on the form **given at Orientation**
11. ____ State Fire Marshall Candidate Fingerprint Receipt (original) - Directions will be **given at Orientation**
12. ____ Full payment for the program:
 \$2,050.00 for Tampa Fire (plus, students must rent their own bunker gear = approx. \$1,000)
 (Note new price. The State made a change in the program length from 398 hours to 492 hours)

(You must to be prepared to pay in full for the program when you register. Or, if an agency (CareerSource WIOA, VA, VR, Florida Prepaid, Florida Bright Futures, etc.) will be paying, you must bring a letter, voucher, or other proof that they will pay. Until you have that documentation, you will not be allowed to register. If the agency pays part of the costs, you will have to pay the remaining costs at Registration. See the information under the “Financial Aid” link for details. Note: VA, Florida Prepaid, and Florida Bright Futures programs do NOT pay the full cost.)
