Early release days for the 2020-2021 have not yet been determined.

All enrolled students will receive a postcard during the first week of August with instructions to check our school website to view important back to school information including **teacher assignments**. The label on the postcard will include your child's name and a number code to determine the assignment when you visit the website. If your post card doesn't arrive by Monday, August 3rd, you may come to the school office to receive your child's teacher assignment (please bring ID and proof of current residence).

School hours are 7:40 a.m. – 1:55 p.m. Students are not permitted on campus before 7:10 a.m. unless they are enrolled in the HOST morning care program. If you are interested in enrolling your child in the morning or after school care program, please check the district website for registration information. (<http://www.sdhc.k12.fl.us/doc/1418/onlineregistration>). **Breakfast and lunch** are served daily. Breakfast is served from 7:10 -7:35 a.m., and is free for all students. Students may purchase a school lunch for \$2.25.

We will be modifying our procedures as needed in response to current information and directives. Thank you in advance for your flexibility and understanding as we work to be responsive to ever-changing situations.
