#### STUDENT PARKING - GRADES 10-12

#### Students have the responsibility to:

- Be fully aware of their responsibilities in the operation of vehicles on the school grounds;
- Abide by the rules and regulations established for the safety of the student body;
- Park in the parking lot designated for students;
- Have a parking hangtag with registration number displayed as directed by the school.

## Students violating any parking regulations shall be subject to the following consequences:

- 1st Offense Verbal Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense Sticker Violation
- 3rd Offense Parking fine of \$25 (will be placed on indebtedness list if not paid)
- 4th Offense Suspension of parking privileges on campus for the remaining of the semester and disciplinary action
- 5th Offense Suspension of parking privileges on campus for the entire school year and disciplinary action

Student must exercise extreme caution when entering and leaving the parking area. The maximum speed limit on the school grounds is 5 MPH. The school is not responsible for damages or theft to automobiles, trucks, bicycles, or motorcycles. The school is not responsible for damages to or theft of the contents of these vehicles.

# PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

### **Parking Procedures**

- Hang tags must be hung from the rearview mirror and visible through the front windshield.
- Students must park forward into parking space. Do not back into space.
- Students must drive single-file while entering/exiting the school. No passing.
- Upon arrival, students must park, exit vehicle, and enter the building for the start of the day.
- Students can only park in the Student Parking Lot. Students cannot park in Visitor or Faculty Lots. Senior Spaces are only for those seniors who purchased them.
- OJT/Virtual/Dual-Enrollment students will have a different hangtag.
- Students must NOT cut through faculty and/or visitor parking lots. Use student exit(s) only.
- Students are expected to drive safely, defensively, and follow the speed limit, 5 MPH.
- Students may not re-sell their hang tags. Seniors may not allow underclassmen to use their Senior hang tags or parking spaces.
- No students are allowed in the parking lot during the school day or during lunch periods. Vehicles are NOT to be used as lockers.

Speeding Riding in Truck Beds Leaving Trash in Their Space Area Loud Music Driving Over Tire Stops Not Wearing Seatbelt Reckless Driving Leaving campus w/o permission Excessive Late Sign-Ins Giving keys/vehicles to students who drive off campus.
