I know your questions are endless and hopefully this letter will help you be at ease knowing that your child's safety is our top priority and we are doing everything we can to make it even safer for your child. We are continuously brainstorming, planning, and implementing ways to ensure their safety. On August 3, a school wide video will be presented with our school's policies and protocols we will follow; from arrival and dismissal, specials, lunchroom, and activities in the classroom. Just keep in mind that as things are changing, we will be too. The staff at Hunter's Green Elementary goes above and beyond for all our students, all of the time. They work endlessly to follow protocol and procedures with your child's safety being first.

We are still planning our Meet and Greet on Friday, August 7, from 12:00 – 4:00, however, it will be by appointment only. On August 3, each teacher will send a sign-up genius link for you and your child to make an appointment for a 20-minute meeting with the teacher. Please make sure your email address is up to date as this will be one of our modes for communication. Only three families per class will be allowed at a time on the classroom. We are asking if you have more than one child that will be with you, to please make arrangements with the teacher prior to scheduling. You will enter either the side gate at the front of the school or the side gate by the car line, wear a mask, and sign in. During that time, you can drop off your child's supplies. Please make sure they are labeled. You will also receive a car tag if your child will be a car rider at anytime during the school year.

We are recommending that the staff and students wear masks. Even though our school will provide 3 masks to each child, PTA will be selling a Hunter's Green Elementary mask. You can find these on the PTA website at [huntersgreenpta.com](http://huntersgreenpta.com).

If you haven't selected your option for the new school year (**Option A:** Full-time Return to School, **Option B:** Full-time School-Based eLearning, **Option C:** Hillsborough Virtual K-12) please do so by July 10<sup>th</sup>. This will help us finalize our plans for the 2020-2021 school year.

Please know that all policies and procedures outlined in this letter are subject to change in response to official health and safety directives from the CDC, State of Florida, and our School District. We will be modifying our procedures in response to current information and directives. Thank you in advance for your flexibility and understanding as we work to be responsive to ever-changing situations.
