Important things to know:

1. TEACHER ASSIGNMENT:

If you will look at the address label on your letter you will see a four-digit number in the right hand corner. Match this number with the attached teacher name/number sheet and you will have your child's grade, teacher name, and room number.

EXAMPLE: To the parents of: KG 01
Jane Ross

The first two digits "KG" show the child is in kindergarten. The last two digits "01" identify the teacher. These instructions are also on the Student Placement Sheet.

2. FIRST DAY:

School will begin on Monday, August 24, 2020. Teachers will share schedule for E-Learning. First day on campus will be August 31st. Classes begin at 7:40 a.m. Students should be in their seats by 7:40 a.m. or they will be considered tardy. Students should not arrive at school before 7:10 a.m. Supervision is provided starting at 7:10 a.m. School hours are 7:40 a.m. to 1:55 p.m.

3. FIRST DAY PROCEDURES:

On the first day of school, staff members will be posted around campus to help direct students to their proper room assignments. Please have your child at the bus stop at least ten minutes before the scheduled time. **Parents, please fill out the name tag on the following page. This will assist us in getting your child to his/her class. Also, please complete the "travel to and from school" information. Pin this to your child's shirt with a safety pin.** We encourage you to monitor your child at the bus stop in the morning and afternoon. Parents are responsible for student conduct prior to bus pick-up and after bus drop-off.

4. DROP-OFF/PICK-UP:

Car riders should be dropped off after 7:10 a.m., on the ramp on the side of the Cafeteria. You are encouraged to allow your child to ride the bus if transportation is provided for your community. This will help reduce the number of cars during these periods of time. WE GREATLY APPRECIATE YOUR COOPERATION AND UNDERSTANDING.

5. CHANGE OF TRANSPORTATION:

Please notify the office either in person or in writing of any transportation changes. Any emergency change should be done prior to 1:15 by fax with your picture I.D. The school's fax number is (813)740-4186. Sign outs will end at 1:30 P.M.

6. LUNCHES:

School lunches are \$2.25 and breakfast is FREE. The free meal program is available. Applications and information will be sent home by the school district.

7. BACKPACKS:

Each student should have a backpack. This will ensure the safety of school supplies as well as personal items.

8. OPEN HOUSE: Open house, an opportunity to meet your child's teacher virtually, will be on Thursday, August 20, 2020, see the school website for your child's teacher's link and time.

Car Riders-Please Read Carefully!

We have been working with our District Safety Office as well as the Hillsborough County Sheriff's office to ensure the safety of all students and staff. The safest option for families is to utilize bus service or the carline, unless you truly do walk home with your child to a nearby neighborhood (such as Ivy Estates or Winthrop). We do not permit parking on our property and walking up to the carline. Those who wish to park off property and pick up at the marquee should designate their student as a walker.

- Please display Car Tag with your child's information from your rearview mirror.
- You will enter the car line via Watson Rd into the back parking lot. We will have 9 cones set up for drop off/pick up. Please be sure to follow the directions of the staff on duty to ensure you proceed to the correct cone. A staff member or patrol will open the door for your student. If in the afternoon your child needs assistance buckling up please continue through the line and pull to one of the reserved spots at the front of the line. All students will utilize the car line including VPK and I-Peeps.
- There will be no drop off in the back parking lot. If you wish to walk your child to the front gate you may park off campus and do so. Our front lot will be closed for bus use only.
- The parking lot in front of the school will be closed for parking between 1:45 and 2:45 p.m. (12:45-1:45 on Mondays).
- Those students who walk home will be dismissed by the school marquee and should exit via the sidewalk there. Please make sure you have designated your child as a walker on his/her teacher's dismissal list. If you wish for your student to walk alone you must complete a permission slip in the office. Kindergarten students must be met by a parent.
- We are requesting that teachers schedule conferences no earlier than 2:25 p.m. so that parents with scheduled conferences can safely enter the school after dismissal is finished.
- There are several "No Parking" signs on the roadway between our school and Bloomindale Avenue. We have been advised that officers will be ticketing cars parked along Watson Road.
- Please also refrain from Cell phone use during care line so that we may all be focused on student safety.

We are asking for everyone's cooperation as we strive to make the safety of our students and staff our first priority. If you have any questions, please call our office at 740-4182.
