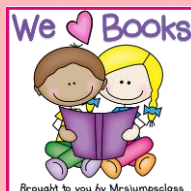
Meet our ESE Specialist MRS. NOLL

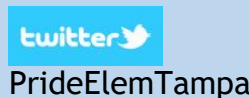
SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR - October 22-30
